NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

1. All races shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the Riverside Dyer Dinghy Association (RDDA) Sailing Instructions.
2. PFD's must be worn at all times while on the water. The RDDA strongly recommends that sailors wear a Drysuit while sailing.
3. A modified Audible-Signal System as defined in Appendix U of the RRS shall apply.
